

### Customs Check

- ▶ Any incoming or outgoing shipment containing specimens of protected species must be checked by the customs authorities.
- ▶ This checks may be done only at designated points of import/export
  - ▶ published in the Official Journal of the EU
- ▶ No customs procedure shall be authorised until the required documents are presented (Art. 13 (2) Reg. 865/06)

### Customs Clearance

- ▶ Are all required documents available?
- ▶ Are all required documents valid?
- ▶ Do the goods/specimens match the description?
- ▶ Does the shipment match any points of your risk analysis?
- ▶ Are there any indicators on irregularities?
- ▶ **Last but not least: be aware of your own risk while handling live animals (health and safety)**

### Check of documents

**Requirements of a CITES export document**  
Res. Conf. 12.3 Permits and Certificates

- ▶ Full name and logo of the Convention
- ▶ Issued in one of the working languages of the Convention (English, French, Spain)
- ▶ Complete name and address of the issuing authority
- ▶ Name of the signatory and handwritten signature
- ▶ Embossed seal or ink stamp
- ▶ Complete name and address of exporter and importer
- ▶ Unique control number, date of issue and expiry date
- ▶ Description of the specimen, quantity and used marks
- ▶ Scientific name, source and Appendix
- ▶ Security stamp if used by the country
- ▶ Information about quotas
