1. STUDY VISITS AT THE COURT OF JUSTICE OF THE EUROPEAN UNION (CJEU)

Presentation

The study visits will be organized at the Court of Justice of the European Union, the aim of these visits is to provide a deeper knowledge on the powers, organization and functioning of the court. The visits will include:

- Presentations given by members of staff of the Court on Court's competencies, procedures and case law
- Presentation on procedures of the Court of Justice (followed by question & answer session)
- Hearing session

Requirements

- A judge, a prosecutor or a judicial trainer

2. STUDY VISITS AT THE EUROPEAN COURT OF HUMAN RIGHTS (ECHR)

Presentation

The study visits will be organized at the European Court of Human Rights, the aim of these visits is to provide a deeper knowledge of the Court, its functioning and its case law. During the study visits members of the court will give presentations on various topics and participants will engage in:

- Presentation of the Convention and sessions on specific issues of human rights articles.
- Presentations on Court's competencies, procedures and case law
- Presentation on the activities of the Office of the Commissioner for Human Rights
- A hearing session
